CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER REVIEW / APPROVAL:



1) Establishment & Quorum

- a) The Committee was established by Council resolution on November 23, 2021 and is given authority though the City Committees Policy C102.
- b) Quorum is established as three (3) or more voting members.

2) Mandate

- a) The mandate of the Committee is to:
 - i) Provide a community perspective and input on emerging needs that would enhance parks, recreation and culture in the community;
 - ii) Advise Council & staff on strategic priorities and policies related to parks, recreation and culture in Pitt Meadows using the <u>Parks, Recreation and Culture Master Plan</u> as a guide;
 - iii) Review and provide feedback on Parks, Recreation and Culture policies under consideration by staff; and
 - iv) Advise on matters referred to the Committee by Council, the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) or the Director of Parks, Recreation & Culture.

3) Membership

a) Voting Members

i) The Committee will be comprised of up to eleven (11) voting members.

The following sector representation will serve as a guide for membership:

- (1) One (1) member with experiential knowledge of inclusiveness and accessibility;
- (2) One (1) youth or young adult;
- (3) One (1) representative from dicəy (Katzie) First Nation (KFN), nominated by KFN's CAO; and
- (4) Up to eight (8) members from the general public, who have an interest in parks, landscape architecture/parks planning, arts, culture and/or recreation, or whose organization provides services in Pitt Meadows and holds interest in one or more of these stated areas.

b) Non-Voting Members

- i) The Committee may include the following **non-voting members**:
 - (1) One (1) Council Liaison and one (1) Alternate;
 - (2) One (1) Staff Liaison, who will Chair all meetings;

- (3) One (1) Committee Clerk; and
- (4) Other staff liaisons may be appointed as deemed appropriate by the CAO to support the initiatives of the Committee.
- (5) Other staff resources as appointed and deemed advantageous by the CAO.

4) Term

a) Appointments to the Committee will be for a two (2) or three (3) year terms to ensure staggering and continuity of the Committee unless otherwise determined by the CAO.

5) Budget

a) There is no budget assigned to the Parks, Recreation & Culture Advisory Committee.
